STEM @ Pilgrim

I suspect you have heard about one of the newer 'names' around in education, which is STEM. This acronym stands for Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics. It is not a subject or a course, but they are areas of study which are part of our teaching and learning programs.

Special areas require a focus, so we are creating a **STEM Space** in the refurbished Computer/Year 2 room. This space is multi-purpose and will also be used by Learning Support and our Junior Primary classes.

Each Wednesday, Mr David Jenkin has been planning and now setting up this new space, with resources both natural and purchased. New furniture will be ordered and students will soon find things to investigate in this space.

Our Campus Library is already operating a **Maker Space** and this is open every Tuesday. Our plans for the Library are also based around a special STEM area as well. Mrs Hajnalka Molloy is doing a wonderful job of providing an exciting environment for our Campus students.

This year we want to set a new whole school record and aim to get at least 150 students to finish the Challenge. If every student takes part, we go in the running for a very special school prize from the Premier!




